Workshops for Schools and Families

Stories and Songs

45 -60 min, 5 and under Have fun sharing a book, playing instruments, moving our bodies, and singing songs. This session can include a short craft activity linked to the book for children aged 3-5.

How to Haiku

60 - 90 min, 6 -11 year olds Discover a brand new world and learn how to write a Haiku. Finish by creating your own arty postcard featuring your Haiku.

Storyteller's Voice

90 -120 min, 7-11 year olds
Have you ever wondered how
you can change your voice? Learn
some tips and tricks to keep your
voice healthy, energised and
flexible and create new
characters

World Building

90 -120 min, 7-11 year olds Create a world where stories can take place. Learn how to build landscapes where stories can be set and create your own simple puppets to add to your scene.

Poems to Change the World

90 -120 min, 7-11 year olds
From celebrating the
changemakers who have come
before us to standing up for what
matters to us, learn how to create
a poem to change the world.

Quest!

90 - 120 min, 6+ Come and create your own adventure based board game to take home and play. In this two hour workshop, create the world where your board game will take place and decide the challenges that players will face.

Hone your improvisation skills and dive into a deeper understanding of listening and staying present when telling tales. Learn some to explore how you can keep focused on telling the tale alongside being open to what our audience likes
